CAiSE'03 is the 15th in the series of International Conferences on Advanced Information Systems Engineering. This edition continues the success of the previous conferences, a success largely due to that fact that, since its first edition, this series has been able to evolve in parallel to the evolution of the Information System methods and technology, following and often anticipating the deep changes that have occurred, since the late 70s when the first CAiSE Conference was organized by Arne Sølvberg and Janis Bubenko.

"Information Systems for a Connected Society" has been chosen as the leading theme for this year's conference. A Connected Society is the goal of the confluence of information systems, telecommunication systems and their application in business, government as well as in everyday life. The scenario is complex from a technological point of view. The pervasiveness of infrastructures for modern information systems greatly extends the demands on engineering information systems in terms of scalability, quality, dependability and adaptability. Information Systems for a Connected Society will be multi-medial, multi-modal, multi-lingual, and multi-cultural. Situation and location awareness will allow users to cope with the complexity of these systems.

The conference venue is in an excellent location for talking about connected societies. The three major European language and culture groups: Romanic, Slavic and Germanic meet here. History teaches that „being connected“ - being within reach - is not enough for interacting, learning from each other, and sharing of achievements. It needs curiosity, and interest, and opportunity, and infrastructure, and ambition. This year's CAiSE is organized by people from three different countries in this Alps-Adriatic region - Austria, Italy, and Slovenia - to further demonstrate that borders diminish and become friendly interfaces in a Connected Society.

The conference week offers a very dense technical program. We hope that you nevertheless will find the opportunity to enjoy the surroundings: the lake, the green hills, the surprisingly changing perspectives of lakeside walks.

Two **panels** offer a discussion on controversial topics: the engineering quality of current web-Engineering practices,
"Web Engineering – Software Crisis 3rd ed.?"
and the perspectives of mobile learning:
"Mobile Learning – Hype or Awarding Challenge?".

In addition, the program includes **technical sessions** with presentations of 45 high-quality technical papers, carefully selected by the program committee out of 219 submissions.

The **CAiSE'03 Forum** is an experience: A platform for the rapid dissemination of recent results in form of posters and demos, based on peer-reviewed short papers. We expect the CAiSE Forum to be an interaction ground where people with similar interest can find each other. We hope to provide a stimulating setting for communication.
